Straupe Old Post Station



The Straupe Old Post Station was one of the biggest and most important stations of the Vidzeme province. Initially the complex consisted of a post-station building, a stable, a barn with a coach-house, and a smithy. In the 19th century, a shed, an ice cellar, a bathhouse and a small stable for sick horses were added to the building complex.

In the hands of caring owners, turning has now been turned into a beautiful and important cultural and historical complex. Since 21 August 2016, on 1st and 3rd Sunday of each month, the Old Post Station is houses of a Straupe Farmers' Market. It offers a wide range of products grown and produced in nearby farms. Great importance is attributed to the quality of products sold, and this why the Straupe Farmer's Market is included in the international Slow Food movement, which emphasizes both locally grown and organic products.
